Contract Jurisdiction

a) in matters relating to the supply of goods, the goods were supplied in whole or in part;

A plaintiff may bring an action in contract in the courts of a State in which B

b) in matters relating to the provision of services, the services were provided in whole or in part;

in matters relating both to the supply of goods and the provision of services,

- performance of the principal obligation took place in whole or in part.

 2. A plaintiff may bring an action in contract in the courts of the State in which the defendant has engaged in frequent or significant activity, or has [intentionally] directed
 - such activity into that State, for the purpose of promoting or solicitating business, or negotiating or performing a contract, provided that the claim is directly related to that activity.
- 3. The preceding paragraphs do not apply to situations where the defendant has taken reasonable steps to avoid entering into or performing an obligation in that State.
